Annual Hero To Hero Awards

The annual Hero-to-Hero Award is presented to brave individuals who best embody the spirit of Firefighter Stephen Siller.

Port Authority Police Officer Christopher Charles Amoroso was just 29 years old In September 2001, when he responded heroically to the WTC attacks.

Trained in special tactics and fire control, after learning that a plane had just

struck Tower 1, Chris rushed to the scene and was active in the early stages of the disaster. After rescuing many people, which has been memorialized in photo graphs taken by the press, he was last seen re-entering Tower 1. Born on Long Island, Chris was raised in North Bergen, N.J. A zealous Yankees fan, he played many sports, loved history, and enjoyed the Jersey Shore. It was there that he met his future wife, Jaime. They were married for two years and had a daughter, Sophia. In a letter found by his wife posthumously, Christopher wrote to 18 month old Sophia, referring to her birth as the greatest day of his life. His legacy to his family is that he will live on in the pride they have in knowing he was a true

Lt. Slutman, was one of the soldiers killed by a roadside bomb on April 8 during a convoy near the Bagram Airfield in Kabul.

Christopher joined the FDNY in 2003 and had most recently been working at Ladder 27 in the South Bronx.

In 2014, the city honored him with the Fire Chiefs Association Memorial Medal for bravery after he rescued an unconscious woman from a fire in a Bronx apartment building.

Lt. Slutman is survived by his wife Shannon, daughters, McKenna, Kenley and Weslynn and his parents, Fletcher and Mary. Firefighters honored him as his remains were driven over the Delaware Memorial Bridge, up the New Jersey Turnpike and over the George Washington Bridge into New York.

Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers Foundation just finished building a SMART HOME on Staten Island for a local Vietnam hero. Welcome home Sgt Michael Sulsona, USMC



On January 15, 1971, while on patrol in an infantry unit in central Vietnam, USMC Sgt Sulsona stepped on a land mine resulting in multiple wounds, including the amputation of both legs above the knee. After weeks spent in a hospital in Guam, Sgt Sulsona was transported to the Philadelphia Naval Hospital. He was awarded the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star with "V" for valor.



On Sept. 11, 2001, Stephen Siller, a 34 year old fire-fighter from Staten Island, took his final heroic steps as he ran with his gear through the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel to the World Trade Center to help save others. Thousands of lives were saved that day, but this was not to be Stephen's destiny. On that tragic summer's day, 9/11/01, Stephen had just completed his scheduled tour with the FDNY, and was traveling to meet his brothers to play a traditional round of golf. However, he decided to go back and help others, and unfortunately Stephen and thousands of others died that day.
